How many treatments are recommended?

Most patients will see an improvement in skin appearance and irregularities following morpheus8 treatment. However, to achieve optimal results, a series of treatments may be necessary. The number of treatments required will vary depending on the individual, but typically 3-6 treatments are recommended for optimal results

How long do results last?

Morpheus8 results are long-lasting, but individual results may vary. Most patients will see an improvement in skin appearance and irregularities following treatment.

What are the side effects?

Morpheus8 side effects are typically minimal. You may experience some redness or swelling in the treated area, which should dissipate within a few days. There is no significant downtime or recovery required after treatment and you can resume your normal activities immediately following the treatment. Results will vary depending on the individual, but most patients will see an improvement in skin appearance and irregularities following Morpheus8 treatment

- What area can be treated?
 - Morpheus8 can treat skin laxity and aging on the face and body, providing anti-aging results virtually anywhere.
- What make Morpheus 8 different?

Morpheus8 is different from other skin and tissue remodeling procedures because it delivers exceptional results with minimal risk of post-inflammatory hyperpigmentation. This makes it suitable for all skin tones, even darker skin.

Does it hurt?

The treatment should be tolerable with topical anesthesia to numb the treated area. Morpheus8 is considered a tolerable procedure concerning pain levels. It employs very sharp and fine needles that puncture your skin. The patient will feel a slight prickling sensation followed by a warm sensation as the needles pass over their skin. During the procedure, the provider treats the area with numbing creams and other numbing solutions to ensure a pleasant experience.



- What are the Morpheus8 treatment benefits?
 - o improves the appearance of fine lines and wrinkles
 - o firms and tightens mildly laxity skin
 - o smooths skin texture
 - o reduce the appearance of large pores
 - o treat hyperpigmentation, acne, acne scarring, and rosacea

- How quickly will I see results?

Patients will notice visible improvements within a few days following the procedure, but more noticeable results will gradually appear as the collagen and elastin production processes take place. Improvements will continue for up to three months after the treatment.

- What is the down time and aftercare?
 - Immediately after the <u>treatment</u>, you will look and feel like you have a moderate sunburn. Expect your skin to have a pink or reddish hue (<u>erythema</u>). Your skin may also feel warm and tighter than normal. There may be a little edema (swelling) and superficial bruising around the eyes. Crusting and peeling for three to seven days post-treatment is also common. You may notice small needle marks on the treatment area, but don't worry! They will disappear in about three days. If you've had a more aggressive treatment, they should be gone after approximately a week.
- What to expect during your treatment?
 - Morpheus 8 treatment takes approximately 1 hour. During the treatment you will feel heat and pressure on the treatment area. You will be asked to arrive early to allow time for numbing of the area. We use a topical numbing cream to numb the area and minimize discomfort.
